REQUIRED LABORATORY TESTS: Please gather and submit the following lab results. Missing lab results may delay your evaluation

- I have had prior neck surgery
- All recent INTACT PARATHYROID HORMONE (PTH) LEVELS
- recent TSH THYROID FUNCTION TEST
- recent FREE T4 THYROID FUNCTION TEST
- 24-HOUR URINARY CALCIUM LEVEL

IMAGING AND LOCALIZATION STUDIES (if available): Please provide any of the following studies that have already been performed

- I have had prior neck surgery
- Tc99 Sestamibi scan (Parathyroid scan)
- CT scan or MRI of the neck

Actual Images are Important:

Dr. Harding must review the **actual image files**, not just the radiology reports. Patients are responsible for obtaining these images from the radiology facility and bringing them to their appointment. If left with our office, patients must also arrange to pick them up afterward.

Surgical History (if applicable)

- I have had prior neck surgery
- I have submitted operative reports and any available pathology reports
